Mainz The Golden City

A classic guided tour of the cathedral, the Gutenberg Museum and the Old Town. Since more than 1000 years St. Martin's Cathedral shapes the city of Mainz. A short walk away is the Gutenberg Museum, one of the main attractions, which includes the world famous 42-line Bible, as well as the historic printing press. Afterwards your route will lead you to the historic old town to its half-timbered houses, picturesque corners and squares.

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The Gutenberg Museum - World Museum of Printing

Experience the history of printing, writing, and books in the Gutenberg-Museum. The Gutenberg-Museum, which lies opposite the cathedral in the heart of the old part of Mainz, is one of the oldest museums of books and printing in the world. The Museum was founded by a group of Mainz citizens in 1900 and dedicated to Johannes Gutenberg, today's "Man of the millennium", and his inventions. During a one-hour guided tour through the Gutenberg Museum, enjoy the sight of the original Gutenberg Bible in the vault of the museum.
